



FILM AND VIDEO CENSORSHIP BRIEFING NOTES (short version)

The CAC's position is as follows:

- 1) All films should be released uncut.
- 2) There should be no power to ban films.
- 3) Certificates should be issued, but only as a guide for consumers.
- 4) Parents are responsible for what their children see on the screen. Adults are responsible for themselves.

- 5) There is no cause-and-effect connection between antisocial behaviour on the screen and antisocial behaviour in real life.
