we congratulate you on your appointment and your

declared intention of public consultation on protection of
minors. We therefore request that, as an interested party,
we are given the opportunity to make detailed representations
to you.

We are particularly disturbed by the assumption that British parents are uniquely irresponsible. No other country tries to deny adults access to material on the grounds that it is unsuitable for minors: Britain is one of the only States in the whole continent of Europe which still has State censorship of films and video recordings, as opposed to mere classification. This is because of traditional grundyist English nannyism based on the precept "No Sex Please-We're British!" Qui bono?
