ON THE 18TH JUNE 1998 TED GOODMAN, CHAIR OF CAC, WAS INTERVIEWED ON THE PHONE BY LORNE JACKSON OF THE SPORT NEWSPAPER, 19 GREAT ANCOAT STREET, MANCHESTER M60 4BT, ABOUT SEXUAL LAW REFORM. GOODMAN EXPLAINED THAT THE TOTAL LACK OF SUPPORT FROM ANY MEMBERS OF EITHER HOUSE OF PARLIAMENT MEANT THAT THE LAWS AGAINST OBSCENE PUBLICATIONS WOULD NOT BE CHANGED IN THIS COUNTRY.

JACKSON, WHO IS SCOTTISH, SAID THAT SCOTLAND WAS EVEN MORE PURITANICAL THAN ENGLAND, BECAUSE OF THE FORMER'S CALVINIST TRADITION. HE SAID HE WOULD WELCOME RECEIVING ANY WRITTEN MATERIAL ABOUT THE STRUGGLE FOR REFORM.
