YOUR TELEVISION ADVERTISEMENT BROADCAST ON 15TH APRIL
This is a complaint about your advertisement on two
grounds. Firstly it was salacious and incited complaints about
depictions of sexuality. Are your staff so underemployed that
you have to resort to such tactics? Complaints should be
spontaneous and in good faith, not solicited to provide work
for the regulator.

Secondly the advertisement stated that British television is widely regarded as the best in the world. By whom ? You are hardly impartial judges! In fact British television is amongst the most over-regulated in the world. Your organisation should not have authority over satellite broadcasting. That has resulted in the United Kingdom being the only country in the European Continent to suffer Orwellian thought-control proscription orders against television stations based on the absurd premise "No Sex Please-we're British" Consenting adults should be allowed to watch smartcard satellite material of their choice, even if it is sexually explicit, because minors cannot gain access.
