TASTE AND DECENCY

Thank you for your letter of the 12th. We appreciate you replying in such detail. We have the following answers to the

points you make.

On the 16th May the High Court upheld the liberalising decision of the Video Appeals Committee. Encrypted telelvision is the the equivalent of R18 video recordings (sale of which is restricted to licensed sex-shops). The same standards should therefore apply to both.

Licensed sex-shops exist throughout England, by virtue of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982. It does not apply to Scotland, hence the different legal position there (ie unlicensed sex-shops). In any event the ITC applies national standards and must therefore ignore regional variations.

We agree that bestiality should not be shown on telelvision. That is because it is a criminal offence. Copulation, however, is not illegal!

The Broadcasting Act 1990 empowers, but does not require, the ITC to request proscription orders. We therefore hereby repeat our request that you cease so doing. Please consider this on its merist and let us have your reasoned response.
