Protests halt lesbo rock show

A SHOW by lesbo band Rock Bitch was called yesterday protests about on-stage sex and nudity.

The outrageous French group was due to play at a nightclub in Newport, Gwent, for a TV docu-

mentary.

Tickets to see the band, who have appeared on Channel 4's Eurotrash and The Big Breakfast, had been selling well.

But Jesters nightclub pulled the plug on the concert after a storm of

local protest.

Censor

Local police chief Inspector Julian Knight said: "We had a meeting with the club to remind them of the law and the concerns of the local

community.'

Rock Bitch have played other venues on the understanding they do nothing to offend during their shows. But the eight-strong band had not been asked to censor their show in Newport.

John Marsh, 54, who campaigned against the concert, said: "I'm very pleased. It just shows that if people speak up, things can happen."
