Thank you for your letter of 1 July 2005, addressed to David Cooke, the Director of the BBFC. Mr Cooke has asked me to reply.

We understand that War of the Worlds has received the following international classifications:-

UK – '12A' (suitable for 12 and over, under 12s must be accompanied by an adult) Ireland – '12A' (suitable for 12 and over, under 12s must be accompanied by an adult) USA – 'PG-13' (parents 'strongly cautioned' but under 13s can view unaccompanied) Canada (Ontario) – '14A' (persons under 14 must be accompanied by an adult) Germany – '12' (no persons under 12 admitted) Netherlands – '12' (advisory only)

France – Suitable for all (no restriction or age suggested)

Sweden – '11' (over 11s may view unaccompanied, persons aged 7-10 may view if accompanied) Denmark – '11' (over 11s may view unaccompanied, persons aged 7-10 may view if accompanied) Australia – M (recommended for 'mature audiences' but no mandatory age restriction) South Africa – '10' (not suitable for persons under 10)
