Thank you for your letter of the 8th January 2013. The points we are trying to make are as follows.

- 1. Under the Obscene Publications Act, only possession for gain was unlawful, not mere possession in itself.
- 2. Material which would fall foul of the OPA was not defined by a laundry list. It was left to a jury to decide, having regard to the circumstances of publication ie the target audience.
