CENSORSHIP OF NUMBER PLATES

We corresponded last year. You stated that DVLA withholds numbers
"likely to cause offence or embarrassment."

That infringes the right of freedom of expression, as proved by the US
Supreme Court decision in the COPSLIE case. I enclose a report.

CAC therefore asserts that DVLA must change its policy on withholding
numbers, to make it comply with the European Convention on Human
Rights (Article on Freedom of Expression).
